

Prof. Roberto Orecchia's short biography

Roberto Orecchia graduated from the University of Turin and during his post-doctoral period he obtained degrees in Radiotherapy, Medical Oncology and Diagnostic Imaging.

From 1994 to 2018, he was Full Professor of Radiotherapy at the University of Milan and currently holds the role of Emeritus Professor in the same university.

Since 1994, he is Head of the Department of Medical Imaging and Radiation Sciences of the European Institute of Oncology (IEO) in Milan and from January 2015, he is also the IEO's Scientific Director.

From 2010 to the end of 2018, he was also Scientific Director at the National Center of Oncological Hadrontherapy (CNAO) the only Centre in Italy that uses hadrontherapy with both protons and carbon ions to treat tumours. Currently, he is member of the CNAO's Scientific Board.

His clinical and research activities focus on various fields of radiotherapy and oncology, from the beginning characterized by a strong interest in innovation.

To date he has published over three hundred and seventy scientific articles in journals listed in the Pub-Med.
