

Prof. Thierry Philip short biography

Professor Thierry Philip is a Medical oncologist, Full Professor of medical oncology, currently Chairman of the board of directors of Institut Curie (since 2013) - Lyon municipal councillor - Mayor of Lyon's 3rd arrondissement (since 2008).

He served at the Centre Léon-Bérard, a cancer centre in Lyon and Rhône-Alpes, as chief of service of the outpatient clinic medical unit (1985-87), head of the bone marrow transplant unit (1987-89), and then as the centre's director (1989-2009), also serving as coordinator of the paediatrics department (1996-2000); he also founded the Cancer-Environment-Health Economics department in 2009.

President of the Fédération Nationale des Centres de Lutte Contre le Cancer (French National Federation of Cancer Centres), which became Unicancer in 2010 (1997-2002);

President of the Comité National du Cancer (French National Cancer Committee) (2002-03) - Regional councillor (2004-11);

Vice-president (2004-10) of the Rhône-Alpes Regional Council;

President of the Lyon Auvergne Rhône-Alpes cancer centre network (CLARA) executive committee since 2005;

President of the clinical and translational research scientific advisory board at the Fondation Contre le Cancer de Belgique (Belgium Cancer Foundation) since 2011;

Vice-president of Greater Lyon (since 2008) - Rhône general councillor (2011-15);

President of the Organisation of the European Cancer Institutes OEI (2019-2023).

Professor Thierry Philip is author of more than 1000 international scientific publications.
